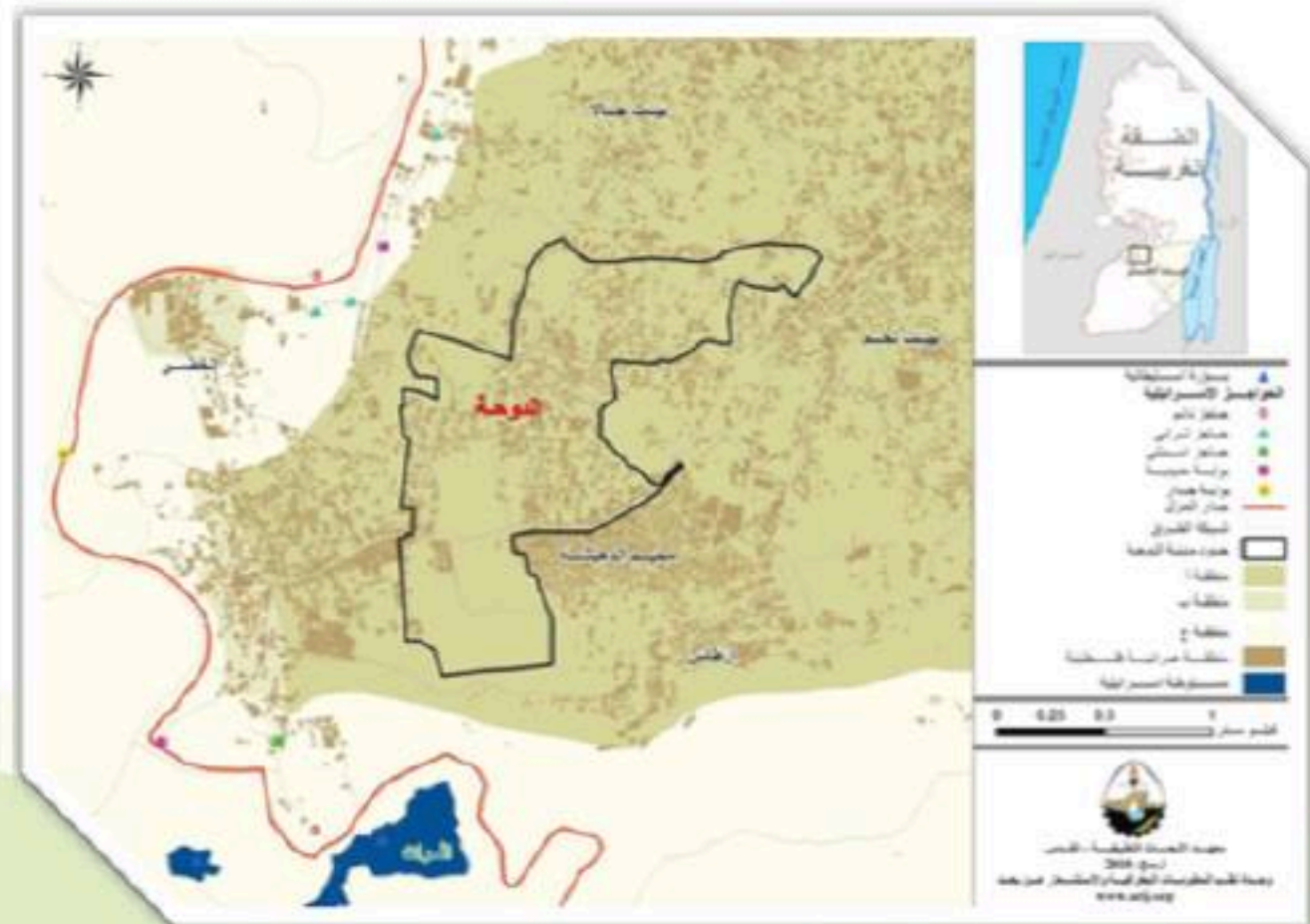


ABOUT THE CITY

The name OF “AL Doha” came forty years ago , the city of AL Doha was part of Beit Jala city , through the generous donation from the government of Qatar , Beit Jala Municipality constructed a main road linking cthe town of Beit Jala from the south-west to reach Jerusalem, Hebron street adjacent to al Duhaisha camp in 1978. From the recognition of the State of Qatar generous donations , the municipal Council called the name of the road “Al Doha”, relative to the capital of Qatar .Doha municipality established in 1996 by a direct decision of the previous Palestinian President Yasser Arafat.



The city of AL-Doha is 1800 acres the population of Al-doha city is about 16000. 90% of the pepole live on it are refugees. Most of Doha citizens move to the city from surrounding refugee camps looking forward calmness, security, and decent life away from the high population density in refugee camps and city centers. Moreover this unique social fabric and collective memory sharpen and strengthen the social relationships between the citizens who have a common ambitions and dreams. In addition this diversification of the people contributes in increasing the numbers of university degree holders , intellectuals, academics and political elite who live in the city. Despite the persistent efforts that exerted by the municipality for more than 20years in all the services delivered to the citizens and in improving the standard of livings of the people live in Doha, the city is still lacks to many vital public institutions and schools .Although five schools were built since the municipality establishment, until now there is a number of students stil study in rented unsuitable stores.
